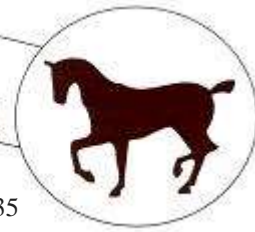

## CONDITIONS

Stall holders are advised that their stalls must be set up and ready for operation by **2 pm Friday 23rd February 2018**. The Showgrounds will be open for setting-up purposes from 7am on Friday 23rd February 2018. **CLOSING TIMES: Stallholders must remain in place until sunset on Saturday 24th February or as determined by the Committee. It is optional for stalls to remain open on Sunday 25th February. This must be advised at the time of application.**

**One vehicle pass and two attendant's passes for each day are allocated to each site.**

**All stallholders must ensure that stalls are of show standard with suitable stands and backing.** This **MUST** be adhered to in the interests of all stallholders and exhibitors. Stallholders shall not assign or sublet any part of allocated space without the consent in writing of the Steward. The site allocated **MUST NOT** be changed without the approval of the Steward.

The Society reserves the right in unforeseen circumstances to amend or alter the exact site of the location of the stand, and the Exhibitor undertakes to agree to the alteration to the site or the space re-allocated by the Society.

Microphones, sound amplifiers and machine demonstrations will be permitted where the level of sound causes no annoyance to other Traders or the visiting Public.

**N.B.** Care should be taken in selecting suitable lines. The Secretary or Steward shall be given power to enter the area prescribed and remove any article, sign, picture or printed matter, as per the Federal Council of Agricultural Society's list of "**Banned Items**".

Stallholders **MUST** have their own comprehensive insurance, as the Society will **NOT** be held responsible for loss of goods or damage.

Any exhibitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with **earth leakage circuit breakers** and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected and tagged by a licensed electrical contractor. This is essential for the safety of yourself, your fellow exhibitors and the general public and is a requirement of **Workplace Health and Safety Act of 1995**. The Act imposes very severe penalties in the event of non-compliance with its provisions. Exhibitors who do not comply will this requirement not be allowed to exhibit at the Killarney Showgrounds. Please check all your electrical equipment and leads before you come, to avoid any difficulties.
